**OUTSKIRTS OF EINDHOVEN, NETHERLANDS, 18 September 1944:** The day after landing and their failed attempt to secure the bridge at Zon intact, Colonel Robert Sink dispatched much of his 506<sup>th</sup> Regiment (also known as the 'Five-Oh-Sink') south into Eindhoven to help prepare for a link up with XXX Corp. When a pair of 88s were reported in the suburbs around Kloosterdreef and Woenselstraat, Company F of 2/506 was dispatched to take out the guns in the flank and rear.

### BOARD CONFIGURATION:



Only hexrows G-AA are in play.

**VICTORY CONDITIONS:** The Germans win at game end if at least one Gun is possessed by a non-broken German crew.

### SPECIAL RULES:

- EC are Moderate, with no wind at start.
- Guns may not be set up HIP but they are treated as Emplaced.
- Boresighting (C6.4) is NA.
- The US Lt MTR has a ROF of 2.

**HISTORICAL RESULT:** Guided by Dutch civilians the paratroopers made short work of the surprised German defenders, with minimal losses. The second 88 was taken out by a 60mm mortar that had been brought up without its baseplate and was just held steady between a paratrooper's legs.
